

## Lost and Found Pattern Errata: Updated 1/28/2020

### Page 2, Cutting Instructions for Inner Border States to:

Cut (3) 8-1/2" Strips WOF and join end-to-end, then sub-cut

(2) 8-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips Inner Border top and bottom

Cut (4) 10-1/2" Strips WOF and join (2) of each end-to-end, then sub-cut

(2) 10-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips Inner Border right and left

### Correction:

Cut (3) 8-1/2" Strips WOF and join end-to-end, then sub-cut

(2) 8-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips Inner Border **right** and **left**

Cut (4) 10-1/2" Strips WOF and join (2) of each end-to-end, then sub-cut

(2) 10-1/2" x **69-1/2"** strips Inner Border **top** and **bottom**

**Page 4, Step 9** States to Take the Inner Border Rectangles and join them together, using the 8-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips for the top and bottom, and the 10-1/2" x 69-1/2" strips for each side, as shown in Fig. 8. Press seams towards the center of the quilt.

**Correction:** Take the Inner Border Rectangles and join them together, using the 8-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips for the **left** and **right**, and the 10-1/2" x 69-1/2" strips for the **top** and **bottom**, as shown in Fig. 8. Press seams towards the center of the quilt. The figure correctly depicts the layout of the border pieces.
